All Equipment, including the fiber, remains the property of LISCO.

LISCO will follow procedures set forth by Iowa One-Call to help locate existing utility lines when installing a connection to its network. However, private lines or systems such as sprinkler systems, buried lines to out buildings, septic systems, drain fields, etc. are not a part of the One-Call system. In an effort to prevent disturbing private lines, please let us know of any private lines you are aware of and provide us a telephone number at which we can reach you to discuss their location. You will be responsible for repairing any damages incurred if LISCO should hit a buried service that was not properly marked.
